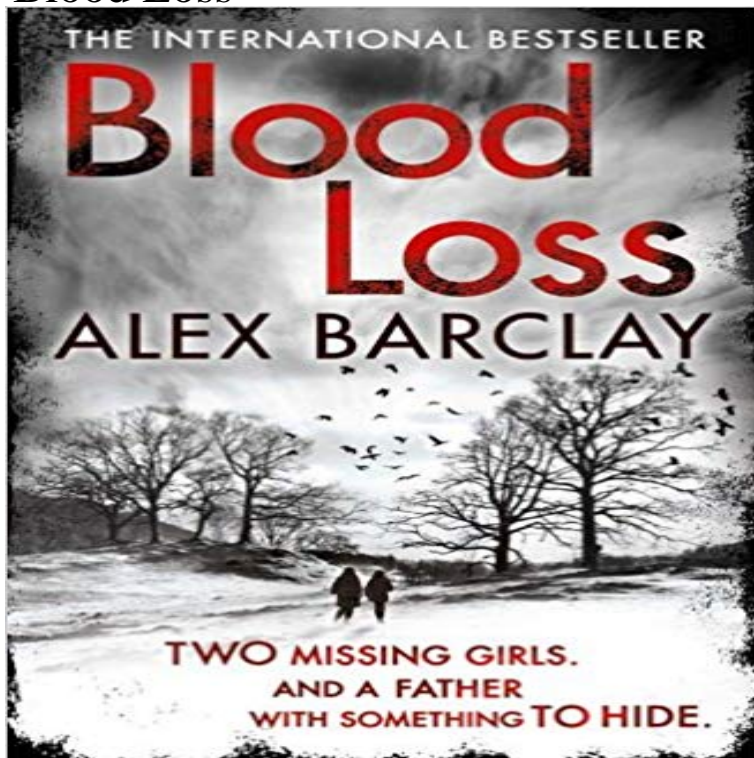


## Blood Loss
