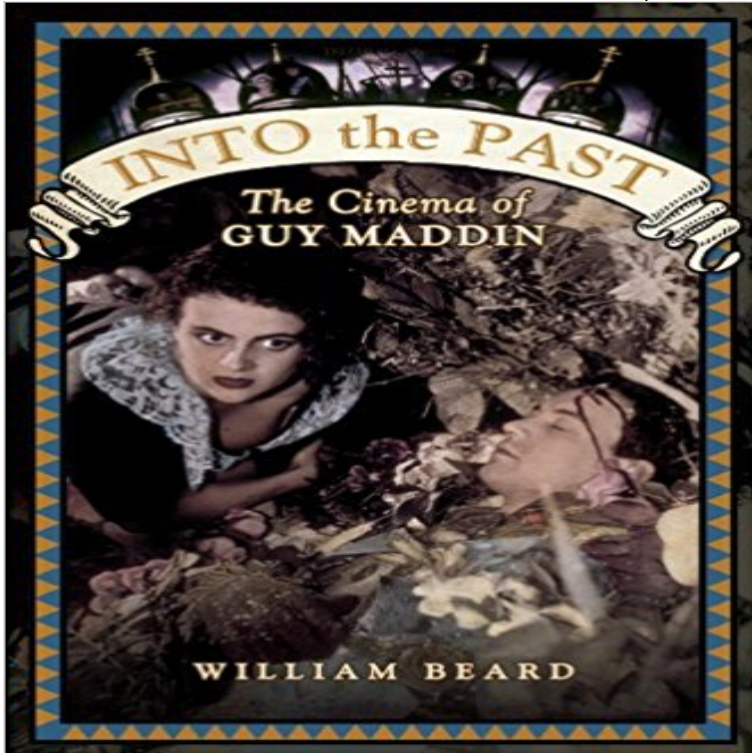


Into the Past: The Cinema of Guy Maddin
