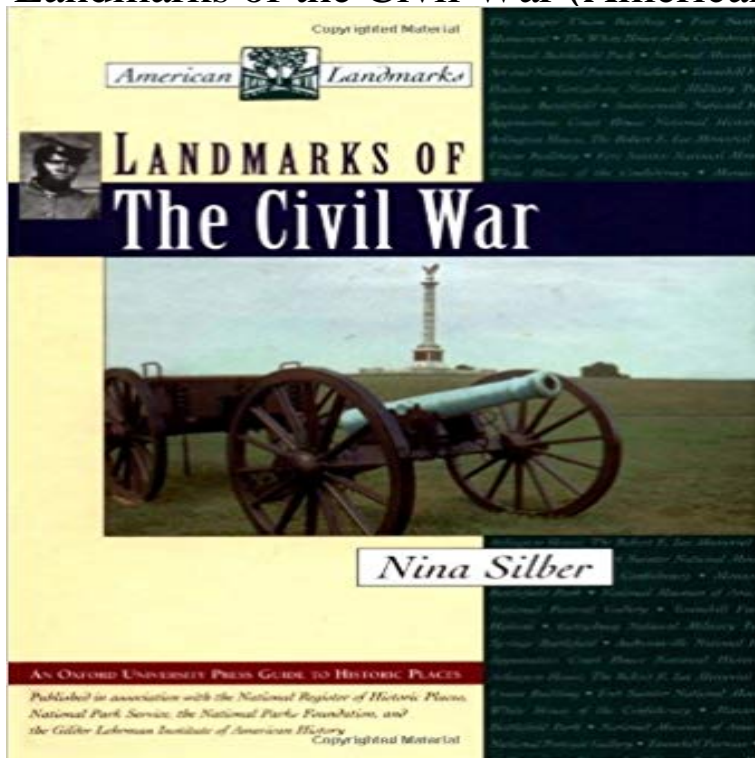


Landmarks of the Civil War (American Landmarks)

With numerous personal anecdotes and compelling detail throughout, *Landmarks of the Civil War* is a fascinating tour through the places where the United States faced its most trying moments as a nation.
