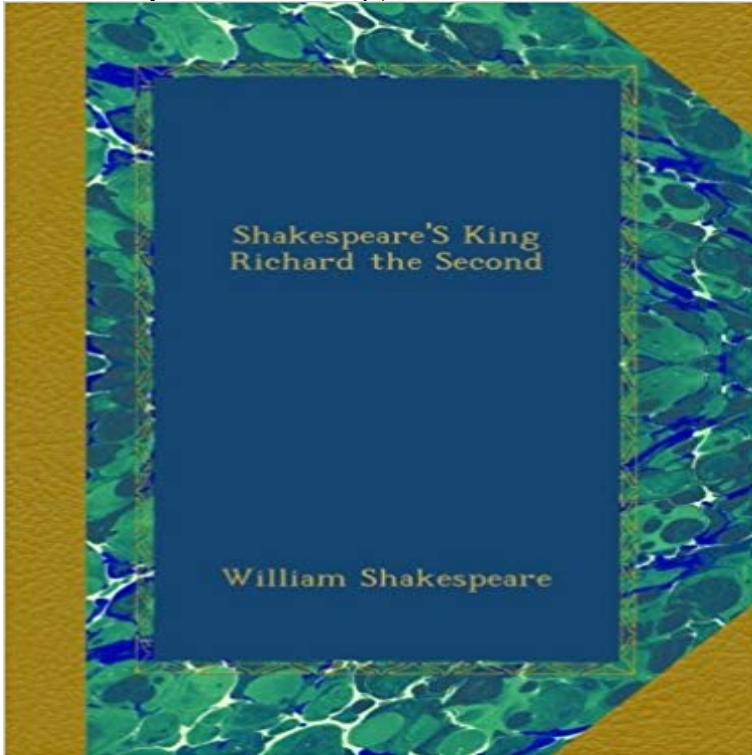


ShakespeareS King Richard the Second
