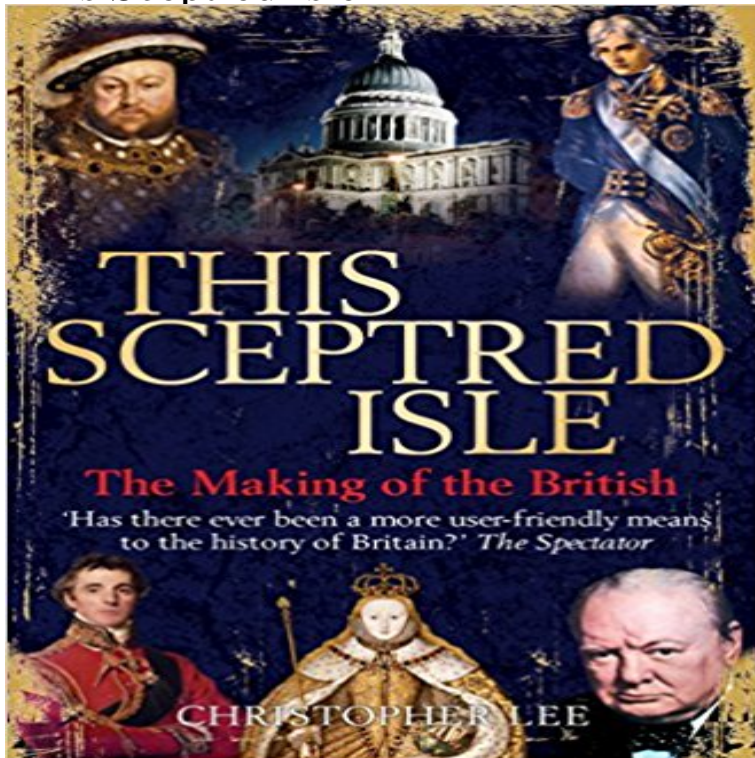


This Sceptred Isle
