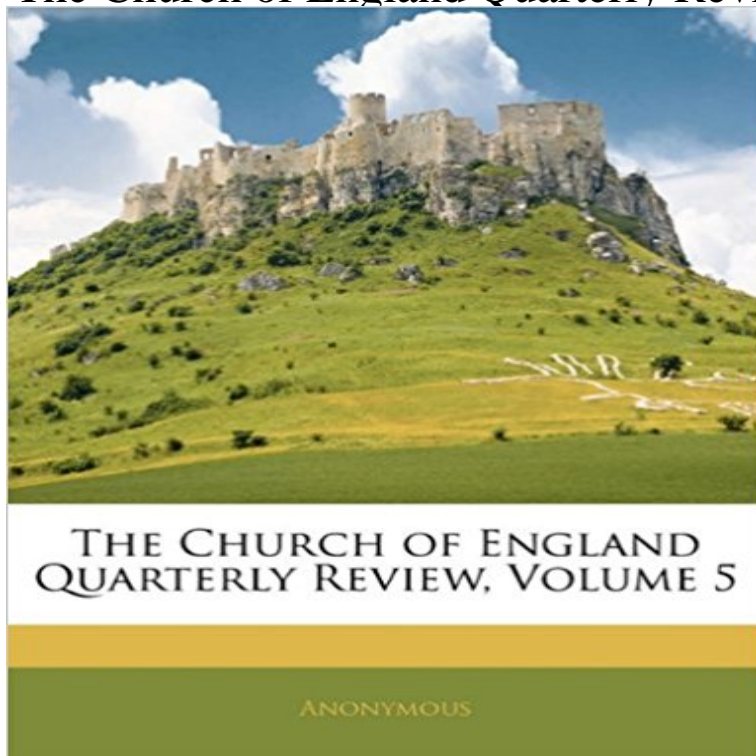


The Church of England Quarterly Review, Volume 5
